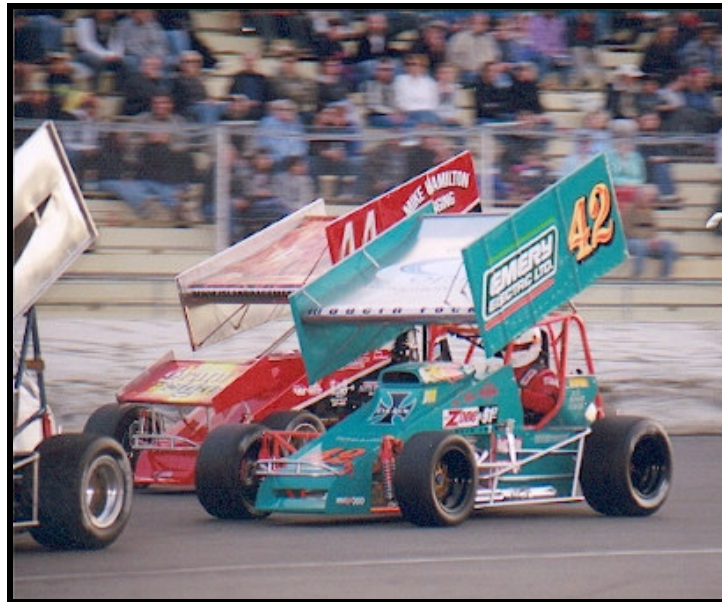


**WilRoc Race 1**  
**May 20, Western Speedway**

Team G-Force came out of the gate swinging with the Zone @91.3 / Emery Electric sprinter this Saturday by qualifying second just one hundredth off the pace. "There is a lot left in it" exclaimed driver Guy Barrett as he unbuckled and the crew set to work dialing the car in. After running both the fast dash and the fast heat races, Barrett was still not completely sure he had what he needed to be more competitive and between himself and Chief tuner Craig Roberts, the decision was made to have the crew make major changes. After changing air pressures, stagger, ride height and fuel weight, Barrett told Roberts "we've changed just about everything, lets move the wing too!" Our team chooses not to run the nose wing and our top wing location a critical tuning factor.



Barrett started the main in eleventh position for the 50 lap Billy Foster Memorial and carefully worked through traffic and a number of cautions picking up spots all night. Giving him fits was the #44 of Scott Aumen who was fast qualifier and sat one position in front of Barrett. As the laps went on, Barrett seemed to get through the corner better and would gain on the outside of Aumen lap after lap. Aumen made his machine extremely wide and as the two made their way to third and fourth, banging wheels along the way, Barrett drove hard into turn three and finally got the run he needed to clear Aumen. A late caution had Barrett on the bumper of second place Randy Vincent and as they came under the white flag, Barrett dove deep inside Vincent into turn one to try and take a shot at leader Mark Fisher. Two open wheel cars do not occupy the same space very well and the #42 sprinter launched skyward onto the back of Vincent and then spun off into the turn. Aumen squeezed past both cars for second and on the restart, took the win for the night. Barrett did get fired off and finished the night in tenth position.
